Lunches can be provided by prior arrangement.

Accommodation is provided in the surrounding B&B compound that includes the Inn, Gover House and Campbell House, which received the coveted Southcott Award for historic renovation. Many of the furnishings are period pieces or have recently been handcrafted by local artisans. Some self-catering vacation homes are available.

Trinity, location of film productions such as *Random Passage* and *The Shipping News*, is one of the best-known communities in the province. Although this picturesque town has a permanent population of only about 350, there are about 50 architecturally significant buildings.

The Artisan Inn is known for its traditional Newfoundland "kitchen parties", with a feast of local entertainment and performances by Newfoundland musicians during the summer.
